- Each CUOS Award victory will add an additional 25 points to your BGOS ranking
- All new is the Creative Use of Space Slopestyle Feature Award: Event Shape Crews from each BGOS event are engaged in a parallel competition to see who will construct the most creative Slopestyle comp-course feature.

- Aspiring CUOS Award Halfpipe winners are challenged to go big, be innovative and garnish one standout trick with an alternative flavor
